SLHCC COVID-19 DAILY UPDATE

DAILY UPDATE: September 14, 2020

CURRENT STATUS: A total of 75 tests were completed today.

There are no additional cases reported today.

There are still 8 confirmed/active cases of COVID-19 on the Saddle Lake Cree Nation. The positive cases have been contacted and are aware; they are following the quarantine/self-isolation guidelines.

It is important for the active/positive cases to remain under active quarantine/self-isolation; and to follow the guidance of the SLHCC Public Health Team. It is also important, for the close contacts, of the confirmed cases, to stay home for 14 days. Contact tracing is on-going. The SLHCC Public Health Team Nurses will continue to phone the close contacts or make necessary home visits.

The SLHCC Nurses ask that all contact phone numbers are accurate and can accept incoming calls; when individuals get their tests done. The tests are sent to the Alberta Health Services (AHS) Lab and processed; the AHS lab will contact each individual directly at the phone number they provided.

Please do not phone the SLHCC medical desk for your results; as they are extremely busy. Details are included on this daily brief on how you can find out your on-line test results.

It is important for Saddle Lake Cree Nation members to continue with the social distancing, frequent hand washing, and sanitization. Masks are required to be worn in all public places, hand sanitizer should be readily available and used prior to entering any SLCN facilities or stores. We can all do our part to reduce the spread of Covid-19 on Saddle Lake Cree Nation.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. Individuals who are under mandatory quarantine/self-isolation should not leave their homes and should not allow visitors into their homes. This will help prevent the spread of COVID-19.
