

ESSENTIAL SERVICES

Saddle Lake Cree Nation Essential Services

- Some programs and services have been shut down; schools, Head Start and daycare, pool hall, Employment & Training, Jordan's Principle.
- Buildings shut down will have a large sign indicating this.
- Essential services and programs currently are using safety protocol while at work.
- All employees are in a rotational schedule coordinated by their managers and/or directors.
- All services and programs have their own limited hours of operation.

Some programs are required to continue to provide essential services to our people. They are operating with minimal staff and where applicable have a rotating staff schedule. They include:

- Water Delivery
- Garbage Disposal
- Health Centre
- Child Welfare
- Social Services
- Education Central Office
- Tribal Administration - Leadership
- RCMP
- Public Works
- Gas Bar & Convenience Stores with minimal hours. 7am to 7pm
- SL Building Supplies
- Pharmacy

There are some new services created to respond to our people's protection and essential needs.

- Food Distribution Centre
- Security/Checkpoints
- Emergency Management Task Force Team
- Call Centre – 8:30am to 4:30pm – Monday to Friday – may need to increase hours based on our status.

GROCERY STORES AND PHARMACIES ARE OPEN – Town of St. Paul

- The St. Paul Co-op and Sobeys has a **senior's hour for shopping, 8am to 9am.** Extra Foods **senior's hour is at 7am. to 8am.**
- Although there has been some over shopping & hoarding, groceries continue to be delivered weekly to all grocery outlets.
