ESSENTIAL FOOD DISTRIBUTION.

We will not be distributing food, until we are in lock down, this is when you will no longer be able to go to town for essentials due to potential community transmission of this virus. We have been planning long term and rightly so, new information indicates that this will take longer than we were initially told. It may take up to 12 to 18 months. Right now as you can see above everyone has the ability to access groceries, cleaning supplies and over the counter medications. It is all of our responsibility to ensure that our homes have adequate essential supplies for ourselves and our families. We are recommending that everyone do their best to purchase a little more each time you go for groceries primarily, personal hygiene products, over the counter medications, babies needs and groceries that can last like; rice, pasta, flour, sugar, beans, lentils, canned goods especially canned meats and frozen fruit and vegetables.
