That the Chiefs of the Confederacy of Treaty Six First Nations held a duly convened meeting on September 26, 2018 wherein the issue of the Rights legislation was discussed.

It is hereby directed to the Grand Chief of the Confederacy of Treaty Six First Nations to:

- Approach the Government of Canada to fund the development of a drafting team to prepare *"An Act to Recognize and Affirm the Right to Self Determination of Indigenous Peoples in Canada"*
- Utilize the Bilateral Rights & Recognition Committee to lead the work of a drafting Team

With the understanding that the process is Without Prejudice and will not hinder any individual First Nation of Treaty No. 6 from pursuing their own process.


