PUBLIC NOTICE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS & COMMUNITY MEMBERS

DECEMBER 1, 2020

In response to the new restrictions announced on November 24th by Premier Jason Kenny, regarding Provincial restrictions in Alberta, the Saddle Lake Education Authority (SLEA) Board met with School Administrators and Emergency Management to discuss what we would do regarding our school re-opening once the community Circuit Breaker period ends on December 2, 2020.

After careful consideration and ensuring the safest method possible for our students the SLEA Board with the support of Emergency Management Team and Leadership have decided that as of December 3, 2020:

- Community school students would continue with Scenario 4 which provides a hybrid of remote learning with online and hardcopy packages with the necessary health and safety measures (at-home learning). This arrangement would continue for the remainder of the school period until the winter break and will be re-visited again before January 11, 2021.
- SLEA school staff will come back to work (on a rotation schedule) and prepare our students for google learning and for preparation of school packages.
- **NO bussing for both on and off reserve until January 11, 2021.**
- Education Office will re-open but doors will remain locked and staff will be on rotation until further notice. Call to make arrangements or appointment, if necessary. Office hours will be from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm.

These precautionary measures is being taken to support the health and safety of the staff and the students that have been affected and slow the spread of the virus.

We will continue to provide additional information to parents/guardians as it is available.
